Organisers said the weekend provided the opportunity for the Indigenous community to come together to share stories and practice culture. Indigenous youth learned about their identity as Aboriginal people while being provided with leadership and mentoring from Koori men. The weekend was supported by Frankston City Council, Arts Victoria, VicHealth and Peninsula Health.
